Utvärderingsformer

Studenterna har gjort en formativ kursvärdering i mitten av kursen. Anonymt har studenterna kommenterat vad som fungerar bra i kursen och vad som kan förbättras.

Studenterna har summativt utvärderat kursen genom en enkät via verktyget Reflex på Canvas.

Sammanfattning av studenternas kursvärderingar

- Bra kombination mellan språkstudier och kulturdelen
- Merparten studenter tycker att läraktiviteterna var fungerande för att nå lärandemålen.
- Merparten studenter tycker att examinationsformerna gav möjlighet att visa hur väl man uppnått målen.
- Flertalet beskriver en hjälpsam, stöttande och tillmötesgående lärare.
- Materialet var tydligt.
- Fokus på uttal och muntliga övningar uppskattas av flera studenter.
- En önskan finns om ytterligare tid till uttalsträning och muntliga övningar.
- Flertalet studenter skriver att de är nöjda med upplägget av culture&society och att föreläsningarna/boken var intressanta. Någon skriver att materialet var för långt. Någon önskar fokus på mer dagsaktuella traditioner.

- Studenterna som deltagit i en blandad undervisningsform visar sig vara nöjda med flexibiliteten att kunna delta på zoom. Någon skriver dock att de föredrar undervisning på Campus.

Sammanfattning av lärarlagets utvärdering

Lärarlaget är i stort nöjda med genomförd kurs. Det är ett stort antal studenter som inte slutfört kursen vilket noteras för att se om det är en ihållande trend. Upplägg för culture&society bör förklaras för studenterna så de får bättre kännedom om att de över 4 kurser i Swedish Language kommer möta olika aspekter av svenskt kultur- och samhällsliv.



4 To what extent do you consider that the course as a whole has met your expectations?







Giving some simple MCQ questions regarding Swedish society

Reading the book did not teach much about culture or society. At least not this century's culture or society. Actual lectures about Sweden's culture and society would be more useful and appreciated: civil rights, traditions, "Allemansrätten", Lucia, Midsummer, history of Swedish kingdom and wars with Norway and Denmark, war neutrality, etc. The lecture covering the historical context of the book's author did more to understand Swedish culture and society than anything else in the book or the assignment or the other 1 or 2 lectures.

For such a short module, the reading of Selma Lagerlöf's book seems to be an adequate approach to provide insights into Swedish culture at the beginning of the last century that features in today's society. However, the book lacks the richness of contemporary Sweden, and I wonder if there is any more recent literature that could illustrate it.

I learned a lot in the Seminar about the Nils H. book. I would have loved to learn a few more things about Swedish traditions that take place nowadays.

I didn't like the study materials. In my opinion Sweden can be introduced via much more interesting and at least a little shorter materials.

Boring. The lecture and the seminar should be restructured, to actually cover the elements of culture and society in the book.


It was good. I could be nice to have classes 2 days per week.
