Summary of the students' course evaluations

- During the continued evaluation dialogue between the teacher and students and the mid-course evaluation, it was clear that students were satisfied with the course content, selection of course themes and course literature. There was no respondent to the final summative evaluation.
- The organization, weighting distribution and types of exams were considered acceptable and reasonable by the students.

Summary of the evaluations of the teaching team

- The students appeared satisfied with the teaching.
- Attendance was consistently high amongst a core group of approx. 60% of the class.
- All students who carried out final exams successfully finished this course with good to very strong results in the different parts.
- As their teacher, I was certainly satisfied with their contributions and their exam performances.
- Based on student performance, it is obvious that regular and consistent attendance is important to attain an adequate understanding and successful completion of both exam tasks.

Analysis

- The zero response rate to the final summative course evaluation very likely indicates that these students did not feel the need to evaluate the course as they were generally content with the various aspects of the course. The students were also provided ample opportunity to contribute their views on the course during the mid-course evaluation and the continual dialogue carried out by the teacher.
- A majority of students finished on time, and there were good to very strong results in the exams.

Action plan

- I intend to incorporate this year's formative student comments and recommendations during future iterations of this course and to, of course, continue sounding out future students' opinions on how the course is run
- Continued and appropriate updating of course content and material.
- More visible integration of this course unit in the research literacy development of the students in this course with a view to helping the students prepare for their MA course thesis work during the following semester.
