Summary of students course evaluations

The students found it difficult to meet the deadlines of the course, mainly because they
underestimated the time required to complete the assignment.

Summary of teachers evaluation

- Based on the students reflections about what they learned during the course (a part of the
 examination) it's obvious that most students have developed significantly during the course and
 reached the learning outcomes.
- I was difficult for the student to handle a course like this independently since it required a large degree of planning, persistency and determination.
- One challenge with the course is to have collaborating organisations in place when the course starts, which is work that needs to be done before the summer before the course starts.
- It was obvious that the students had very different experiences when it comes to Project Managent and that the seminars addressing this content wasn't sufficient to cover some of the students needs for support in this matter.

Analysis

- The outcomes of the course, regarding the results of the students work, shows that the course is relevant, important and developing for the students.
- It's very challenging for the students to complete the course within the ten weeks of the course.
 The teachers should consider making the course a 50% pace course parallel to the following course, IV609G.
- The students should be offered additional support when it comes to Project Management.
