- The first draft seminar was replaced with Canvas-based peer reviewing of the initial drafts due to lack of time to run the seminar. Students saw the value of the first draft seminar and suggested it be reinstated.
- 2. Students suggested an official kickoff to the thesis period.
- 3. There were numerous errors in the Canvas presentation of the course that should be updated.
