As the pandemic were still a factor, the course applied the same structure as previous semester.

The use of the Canvas E-portfolio worked well but caused some problems for both teachers and students. The lack of transparency and the complex line of links to reach the portfolios caused frustration. The structure is dependent of clarification and presence of teachers to work.

It did so for most students but there were some who experienced difficulties and frustration. The course is a foundational training. For some students the workload was to much and for somethe experience were not satisfying due to previous experiences.

The effects of the pandemic were present this semester, even though it was not as bad as 2020. The teacher team were better prepared as this was the second time in this structure even if the E-portfoliostructure still has problems as a workspace.

The differences in expectations and experiences among students caused in some cases dissatisfaction but mostly created a platform for exchanging knowledge and ideas. The E-portfolio system is still not optimal for creating a interactive workspace.

There is a need to present and discuss the foundational level of the course in the start to avoid false expectations among students. 

Jag har haft mycket problem med det base team jag blev indelat med. Många hade inte tid för möten även då de var inplanerade i schemat från första start (vilket var obligatoriskt för att kunna klara av vissa uppgifter) och när redovisning har skett är det inte alltid hela gruppen har närvarat. Många läste inte uppgifterna tillräckligt och ställde upprepade gånger enkla frågor där svaren fanns i uppgiftsbeskrivningen, till exempel: ska man ladda upp detta material på sin e-portfolio? Många av mina gruppmedlemmar publicerade inte sina arbeten i tid vilket gjorde att jag inte heller kunde ge feedback i tid även då jag bett dem ladda upp arbete, öppna upp för kommentarer och länka sin portfolio. Publiceringsdatum för arbetet visas inte (i alla fall inte för oss studenter) vilket skapade en viss oro för mig när dem laddade upp saker en vecka för sent och jag inte lämnat kommentar i tid. Jag tycker kursen har varit rolig och givande men jobbigt att hamna med människor som inte bryr sig lika mycket om kursen.


I know we did a lot but I wanted more. I wanted to learn more about how to visually communicate something, like why certain colors come into play, what the different fonts are used for and for that to be a little more backed up. I'd love to see and abundance of references, like for example when we talked about fonts. Instead of just going over each font type, show examples of when a serif type is used (print, serious contexts, body text) or when a sans serif is used (more legible on screens, block letters for headlines and short messages on posters etc).

As someone who tried really hard, I was a little disappointed on how little some people performed and got away with it. I don't mean you have to be an expert coming into the course, but some things submitted were just not up to par. Do not be afraid to question the students on their choices and criticise their work. A little bit of good and constructive feedback will only help the students get further. You might feel like you did this, and you did, but I would like for it to be a little tougher. I would also have liked more lectures. On the web page it says that we'll talk about memes, movie credits etc. I didn't feel like it really lived up to that.

Now that I've dished out a lot of criticism -- don't get me wrong. I had a good, fun time and I really really appreciated the teachers. Just give us some more tools and raise the bar. I do not find it acceptable to just record someone else's video essay, talk over it and turn it in. What about plagiarism?














